During the holiday season there is a great deal more traffic in this part of town and many people in and around Doctors Complex. Please make yourself aware of this when you are coming and going. In order to help make this a pleasant and safe holiday season, we suggest you:

- Slow down when entering and exiting the parking lots.
- Be sure to lock your car doors and place all packages and valuables in your trunk.
- Use the buddy system when leaving the building after dark.
- Keep purses, billfolds, etc. out of sight and preferably placed in a locked drawer or file cabinet when not in use.
- Lock yourself in your suite if you are working late or on the weekends.
- Stay Alert! Office thieves are most active at opening, closing & lunch hours, when the maximum traffic flow occurs.
- Reception areas should ALWAYS be staffed and other doors leading into your office should be kept locked at all times.
- Be wary of solicitors or suspicious persons. "May I help you?" will often be sufficient to deter a potential intruder. Thieves do not want to be confronted or identified.

Please remember to lock your offices each night when leaving and keep items of value in a secure location both during and after regular business hours.

Also, as you decorate your offices for the holidays, remember the Fire Department prohibits lights being placed on live trees in commercial office space. We ask that you make sure your artificial tree lights are off before leaving your office for the day.

Please remember that employees of the Doctors Building should not park on the north side of Sears (between Sears and Doctors Building) during the Holiday season.

Just a reminder that soliciting is not allowed in the building. Please report all soliciting to the management office.
